

2019 HUMBLE I.S.D. FAIR AND RODEO LIVESTOCK SHOW DIVISION SPONSORSHIP FORM

To insure the continued success of the Humble I.S.D. Livestock Show, each FFA/4H student is given the opportunity to acquire a sponsor for the upcoming Livestock Show. This sponsorship is used to inform people in the community of the FFA/4H program and assure the student a certain success.

Sponsorship is an agreement to purchase an animal (at a predetermined amount set by sponsor and student) at the conclusion of the Livestock Show, if such animal is not placed in the sale. The livestock sale animals will be sold at the auction in February. **IF THE ANIMAL YOU SPONSOR IS PLACED IN THE AUCTION, THIS SPONSORSHIP AGREEMENT IS NULL AND VOID AND RELIEVES YOU OF ALL OBLIGATIONS.** **Sponsors will not be billed if FFA/4H members do not earn the right to show their animal or if they choose not to show.

*The Livestock Show officials recommend the following **minimum** sponsorship prices for each of the seven market livestock divisions:

Steers	\$2500	Sheep/Goats	\$500	Turkeys	\$300
Swine	\$500	Broilers	\$200	Fryer Rabbits	\$350

The support you show is greatly appreciated. **After the Livestock Show, the sponsor will be billed for the amount agreed.** The student is not to be paid directly. **Payment should be made payable to Humble ISD.**

Student or parent must be present during checkout to assure the correct disposition of the animal. The large animals will be transported to the local processing plants listed below. **All processing charges are the responsibility of the sponsor.** The small animals will be processed by the student and delivered to the sponsor free of charge. **Thank you again for your support!**
